Bible Lesson



“Six Days of Creation”

Next week the children will begin learning about all of the wonderful things God created using only his words. We will hear that God made the light, sky, waters, land, trees, flowers, grass, sun, moon, stars, fish, birds, animals, and a man. He created all of these things in six days and when He was finished and satisfied that all was good He rested on the 7th day.

The children will learn that God used only his words to make the above items. No crayons, markers, paper, glue were by God to accomplish His plan. We also will discover how the things God created are all on a planet called Earth. We will examine the Earth and hear how we are just a very small part of the Earth.

Daily Activities

- Explored our classroom: the different centers and everything in each center
- Created brown paint blots
- Learned the words to our wiggle time songs: “I’m His Little Lamb” and “Not Say A Single Word”
